The Position: eLearning mentors are needed to work with faculty, assisting them in developing excellent online teaching skills and helping them understand and use the Canvas Learning Management System. Up to four eLearning mentors may be hired for the remainder of the 2013-2014 academic year. Mentoring duties will begin during Winter quarter 2014, and continue through Spring Quarter, 2014. Duties will include:

- A minimum of two hours per week availability to offer drop-in eLearning assistance, preferably during on-campus scheduled office hours.
- Availability for occasional online eLearning consultations.
- Participation in mentor program evaluation.
- Any additional responsibilities as mutually agreed upon by Federation President and Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs.

QUALIFICATIONS

Required Education and Experience:

1. Current faculty member at Shoreline Community College.
2. Evidence of strong communication skills.
3. Evidence of excellent online teaching skills.
4. Evidence of excellent working knowledge of the Canvas Learning Management System.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

1. Online teaching skills and knowledge of the Canvas Learning Management System.
2. Demonstrated interest in working with faculty.
3. Demonstrated ability to connect with others.
4. Broad representation across instructional divisions.
5. Consistently available to provide information and assistance.

Note: Faculty Mentors will be selected from across the campus to facilitate faculty consultations.
