# PARKING & SHUTTLES

## Visitor Parking

Up to 30 minutes of free parking is available in the Visitor Lot near the main entrance and is strictly enforced. After 30 minutes, additional parking time must be purchased. Current student and employee vehicles parked in the Visitor Lot will be cited.

## Student Parking

Parking is available on the main campus, in the Greenwood Lot, and in the Sears Lot. Student parking lots are designated by green signs with an "S." Valid student quarterly parking permits must be displayed Monday-Friday, 6 a.m.-4 p.m. No overnight parking is allowed without a student housing parking permit.



## Parking Rates

- Quarterly permit: \$45+ tax (purchase at Cashier). Not refundable after the first day of the quarter.
- Daily parking permit:
  - 2 hours: \$3
  - 4 hours: \$5
  - All Day (6 a.m.-4 p.m.): \$7.50
  - Evening (4 p.m.-10 p.m.): Free
  - Overnight Housing Visitor (10 p.m.-6 a.m.): \$7.50
  - Weekends/Holidays: Free

Pay stations for daily/hourly permits have "Pay Here" signs and arrows.

## Pay stations accept Visa and Mastercard

**credit/debit and quarters, no dollar bills.** If using a credit/debit card, allow 30 seconds to process payment. Please notify Safety & Security at 206-546-4633 if there is a problem at a machine. To display a daily/hourly permit, peel off the back and stick the permit, facing out, to the passenger-side window.

## Disabled Parking (Free)

Disabled parking requires a valid Washington State disabled placard. There are disabled parking spots close to most buildings. Cars displaying a valid disabled placard issued to the person in the car are allowed in any parking lot. You do not need to purchase/display a student parking permit if you have a valid disabled placard.

## Student Housing Parking

Residents of 7000 Campus Living should park in the student parking lots west of campus (west of building 1300 to building 1700), accessible through the West Gate. Valid student housing quarterly parking permits must be displayed at all times.

## Other Designated Parking Areas

Parking for employees, visitors, dental hygiene patients, automotive program, Parent Child Center, motor pool, and disabled parking is located in designated areas only and is strictly enforced.


## Student Carpool Parking

Each quarter, Safety & Security offers 10 free student carpool permits to students to park in the Greenwood Lot. To receive a carpool permit, a minimum of two students must apply together, show valid identification and course schedules, and be in classes three days a week (between 7 a.m.-Noon). Carpool permit users must arrive together to use the permit. Violations can result in the permit being revoked.

## Bicycles and Motorcycles

Permits are not required for bicycles or motorcycles, but they must be parked in designated areas, otherwise they may be cited.

Bicycles should be parked in bicycle racks or facilities provided for that purpose. Bicycle must not be: parked in or against a building or near a building exit; on a path or sidewalk; chained or secured to a tree/light pole/sign post; or parked in such a way that obstructs access to College property or endangers pedestrian right of way. Any bicycle found in violation of these rules may be cited a \$25.00 fine and be impounded without warning.



## Free Student Shuttle

Shuttles to and from the Sears Lot run during fall, winter, and spring quarters. Parking permits are not required in the Sears Lot. There is no service during school breaks, holidays, or other school closures. Monday-Thursday: 7:45 a.m.-4 p.m.  
Friday: 7:45 a.m.-2 p.m.
